ACTION REQUIRED

Husky 101 Boston Orientation is mandatory for students. Though optional, family participation is highly encouraged.

Hear from university leadership and academic areas, meet new classmates and families, explore campus and Boston, attend sessions on student life and university services, receive your Husky Card, and access our online course with continued resources to support your transition.

Register Now for Boston Orientation!

- **First-year** students must attend a two-day program, with a required overnight stay.
- Transfer, Global Scholars, London Scholars, Oakland, and Pathway Program completer students must attend a half-day program.

Registration Information:

- Registration for both students <u>and</u> family members/guests is available in the student's <u>Application Status Check</u>.
- Session dates are college/program specific. Students can only select from the date(s) posted in their <u>Application Status Check</u>.
- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a session reaches capacity, the session will show as being CLOSED. The registration deadline is June 1.
- **Travel arrangements** should not be made until the student has registered for a session.
- Campus arrival/departure times and student overnight accommodation information are detailed in the registration process. More information will follow in future volumes of Husky Happenings.
