REMINDER: REGISTER FOR BOSTON ORIENTATION

Husky 101 Boston Orientation is mandatory for students. Though optional, family participation is highly encouraged.

[Register now](#) for Boston Orientation!

Registration deadline is June 1.

- **First-year** students must attend a two-day program with a required overnight stay.
- **Transfer, Global Scholars, London Scholars, Oakland, and Pathway Program** completer students must attend a half-day program.

Student and Family Registration Information:

- **Session dates are college/program specific.** Students can only select from the date(s) posted in their [Application Status Check](#). Students, remember to register your guests!
- **Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis.** Once a session reaches capacity, the session will show as being CLOSED. **Travel arrangements** should not be made until the student has registered for a session.
- **Campus arrival/departure times and student overnight accommodation information** are detailed in the registration process.

- **Husky 101 Boston Guide**
Students and families will receive a *checklist of action items* to complete before starting the fall semester. A sampling of tasks include: uploading a photo for your Husky Card and submitting your immunization requirements, among others. A complete checklist will be a part of the Husky 101 Boston Guide that will be included in Husky Happenings Volume 3, in late May.
- **Online Academic Advising**
Students will receive communication *directly from their college/program as early as May, and continuing through June and July*. It's important to note that online advising and course selection is unique to each individual

college/program. In addition to online advising, there will be academic sessions during Orientation should students need additional guidance.
